6	Excellent, well-focused essay	Liberal use of Latin throughout passage, properly cited. Occasional mistakes do not spoil general impression. Confident.	More important than number of features are quality of discussion, general coherence of argument.
5	Good, strong essay (discerning discussion)	Discussion not as sophisticated, balanced, or well developed as 6 or not as well supported with Latin text; however, the Latin is properly cited and confident.	More than casual familiarity with this passage.
4	Adequate essay	Latin references, though scanty, are specific, accurate, and relevant.	Limited discussion, may be uneven or emphasize only one portion of the text.
3	Limited response or good essay reflecting recall of passage but no Latin support	Latin support is weak, possible misconstrued, inappropriate, or not properly cited.	Response tends to rely on mere translation.
2	Recognizes passage	Limited comprehension of Latin or no Latin cited.	Vague or faulty discussion. Statements demonstrate flawed recollection or are very general or irrelevant to question.
1	Understands question but is unable to write meaningful discussion.	No understanding of Latin or complete misunderstanding. May contain no Latin or individual words randomly selected.	No substantive argument present, though some correct information relevant to question.
